



Calling for Expression of Interest (EOI) from Non-Government Organizations (NGOs)/ Community Based Organizations (CBOs) to work for National Program for Tuberculosis Control and Chest Diseases on TB prevention and control.

Who may apply – Organizations interested in working at national, provincial or district level on TB prevention and control activities focusing on community level surveillance, active case finding and collection of sputum samples to enable TB diagnosis .

Organizations with previous experience of working with the community and proven record in prevention activities will be prioritized.

Background of the EOI – National Program for Tuberculosis Control and Chest Diseases (NPTCCD) which is the national level focal point within the Ministry of Health is collaborating with Global Fund to prevent and control Tuberculosis (TB) in Sri Lanka. According to strategies of the GC7 grant cycle, efforts should focus on establishing a strong partnership with the NGOs/CBOs in conducting the following activities.

1. Conducting community based organization (CBO) led symptoms and risk factor surveillance and patient support in the field. (Districts – Rathnapura, Nuwara Eliya)
2. Establishment of a mechanism to collect sputum samples from home bound elderly for X-pert testings through local NGOs/CBOs in operation and field health workers. (Districts – Colombo, Gampaha, Kaluthara, Galle, Rathnapura, Kegalle, Kandy, Nuwara Eliya, Badulla, Monaragala, Anuradhapura)
3. Retrospective CBO led Active Case Finding (ACF) in urban slums. (Districts – Colombo Municipal Council (CMC) – D1A and D2A)
4. Peer Educator (PE) led Active Case Finding (ACF) among vulnerable males engaging CSOs. (Districts – Colombo (D1, D2A, D3) Kolonnawa, Gothatuwa, Kaduwela, Dehiwala, Gampaha, Kalutara)

The purpose of this EOI is to solicit and select a NGOs/CBOs who would work with NPTCCD to implement this programs at district level.

What documents to submit

1. Covering Letter
2. Organizational Profile

An organizational profile consisting of,

- a. Name, Address, Contact details of organization and its sub offices if available
- b. Copies of Registration Certificates
- c. Vision, Mission, Governance and Management structures strategic plan of the organization

- d. Photos of the mother organization clearly indicating available sub departments
 - e. History of projects and programs on TB prevention
 - f. Bio data of key personnel attached to the organization (Executive Director, Human Resource Officer, Finance Officer, Monitoring and Evaluation Officer, Management structure and reporting responsibilities within the organization)
 - g. Financial statement of projects
 - h. Annual audit reports for the last three years and bank statements
 - i. Confirmations received from organizations on successful completion of projects
 - j. Presence of a peripheral office located outside the Western Province to coordinate district level activities.
- ❖ Above information will be used as selection criteria
Involvement in previous programs funded through GF in the year 2025 shall not be considered as a qualification

Submission of EOI

Expression of Interest must be submitted with a cover letter and in hard copies. The hard copies should include one original and two copies, sealed in an envelope and labelled. A complete EOI will consist of the following,

1. Cover letter
2. Organizational Profile

Short listed NGOs/CBOs will be subjected for an interviews
